

Online Safety for Staff

The presentation is run in your school and lasts an hour. The content is regularly updated and it is presented in a lively way with plenty of interaction, making use of resources from CEOP and other agencies.

It covers a wide range of themes including personal and professional issues, vulnerability, grooming, cyber-bullying, sexting, radicalisation, social media including Facebook, Twitter, Snapchat and Instagram. It also gives helpful guidance to teachers about protecting their online identity and suggests practical steps that schools can use to implement effective E-Safety procedures.

The session concludes with a question and answer session and participants receive a handout containing practical advice.

This presentation covers the latest requirements stated in the DFE's statutory guidance 'Keeping Children Safe in Education' released by the DFE in September 2016.

Endorsed by Police and Crime Commissioners, it is presented by ICT and E-safety experts from Catshill Learning Partnerships who have been delivering Online Safety presentations in schools for over six years across the UK.
